Grades 1&2

Key Points:

- follows rules
- shares with others
- plays under control
- considers the feelings of others
- helps and encourages classmates

Rubric

4 = shows respect for others; participates and plays with physical and emotional control; follows rules without reminders; is willing to extend their sense of responsibility beyond themselves by sharing, helping, and encouraging other students.

3 = shows respect for others; participates freely; needs few reminders regarding rules; frequently plays with physical and emotional control; occasionally will share, help, and encourage others.

2 = under direct supervision, shows respect for others; needs prodding to remain on task; behavior choices often interfere with students own learning.

1 = unable to accept responsibility for own actions; blames others or makes excuses; behavior choices interfere with own learning and the learning of other students.

Grades 3,4,5

Key Points:

- respect for rights and feelings of others
- participation and effort
- self-direction
- caring for others

Rubric

4 = shows respect for others; participates fully in the program and shows outstanding effort; is self-directed; willing to extend their sense of responsibility beyond themselves by giving support to, showing concern for, and helping other students.

3 = shows respect for others; participates with satisfactory effort; is able to work without direct supervision.

2 = under direct supervision, shows respect for others; needs prodding to remain on task; behavior choices often interfere with students own learning.

1 = unable to accept responsibility for own actions; blames others or makes excuses; behavior choices interfere with own learning and the learning of other students.
